

### **Home Economics**

Description: This class is for children with little or no sewing experience. Each student will bring her own sewing machine and should learn over the summer how to set it up and thread it. The first project will probably be a pillowcase.

Class Fee: Families will purchase their own supplies for projects.

Curriculum: none

Length: fall semester

Time: 3<sup>rd</sup> hour on Thursdays, might run over a bit

Class Size: limited to first six

### **Middle School Literature**

Description: Students will read selected books and meet to discuss what they've read. Activities which complement the books may be included. Students will be expected to read at home and come prepared for class. No grade will be given.

Age: 7<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> grade

Leader: Laura Deckert (827-1066)

Class Fee: copying fee of \$5.00 / student / semester plus reimbursing Laurie for the books.

Curriculum: undecided at this writing

Length: fall semester

Time: 1<sup>st</sup> hour on Thursday

Class Size: limited to first 10

Ann Newcomer will hold a meeting on Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup> for students and parents in her math classes (Accounting, Algebra I, Algebra II and Geometry) to discuss book needs and decide additional meeting days. Algebra I and Geometry will each meet twice a week, and Algebra II will meet three times a week. The planning meeting will be held at Oakdale Park at 7:30 pm in the shelter near the playground.

### **Accounting**

### **Algebra II**

Age: whenever ready for algebra II

Class Fee: none, except that you are responsible for obtaining the book

Curriculum: Saxon Algebra II

Length: all year

Time: 2<sup>nd</sup> hour on Thursdays plus two additional days

Class Size: must be at least 4

### **Geometry**

Age: Algebra I is a prerequisite, but geometry can also be taken after Algebra II.

Class Fee: Families must obtain the book, and if enough used copies cannot be obtained, the new edition of this text costs about \$60.00.

Curriculum: Jacobs Geometry

Length: all year

Time: 3<sup>rd</sup> hour on Thursdays plus one additional day

Class Size: must be at least 4

Laura Von Bergen (823-2813) will teach the following history classes. Both classes meet all year. Laura bases the courses on the Tapestry of Grace curriculum which covers world and American history in four years. History 1 is ancient history. History 4 is the 1900's. Homework will be required,

and grades will be given. Both courses also include some geography, church history, and government. Students need to be able to read at a high school level and take class notes. Textbooks are the skeleton of the course, but other foundational books will be needed as well. A list will be available at registration.

#### **History 4**

Class Fee: copying fee of \$10.00 / student / year plus their books

Curriculum: Families are responsible for obtaining the required texts: BJU World History 2<sup>nd</sup> ed. And BJU United States History 3<sup>rd</sup> ed. plus other reading materials needed throughout the year.

Class Size: open

#### **History 1**

Age: 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>

Class Fee: copying fee of \$10.00 / student / year plus their books

Curriculum: Families are responsible for obtaining BJU World History 2<sup>nd</sup> edition plus other reading materials needed throughout the year.

Length: all year

Time: **2:30 Thursday afternoons**

Class Size: open

#### **Spanish II**

Description: This is a high-school level course which will require homework. Students will receive a grade. Students should have taken Spanish I, but Chrissy would perhaps consider new students who have the prerequisite knowledge.

Age: 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

Teacher: Chrissy Brown (309-1166)

Class Fee: \$55.00 / student / semester (Discount for multiple students from same family) plus book and workbook

Curriculum: Bob Jones Spanish I

Length: one year

Time: **9:00 – 10:15 Wednesdays at Salina Bible Church**

Class Size: open

### **Physical Science Lab**

Description: This will meet the lab requirement for a physical science class.

Age: taking physical science, 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

Teacher: Debbie Metzger (823-1488)

Class Fee: The lab book is \$15.00 / student. Supplies are \$30.00 / student.

Curriculum: Debbie will be working from Abeka Physical Science.

Length: all year, most weeks, sometimes meeting at Metzger's home

Time: 3<sup>rd</sup> hour on Thursdays and may run over some days

Class Size: limited to first 15 (2 slots left at the time of this writing)

### **Chemistry**

Description: This is a high school level class which Beth has taught before.

In addition to meeting on Thursdays, she also plans to offer Friendly Chemistry on another afternoon during the fall semester to practice chemistry concepts using games and activities. Beth will coordinate a lab in the spring with KWU. Families may pick and choose what parts of this course they wish to do.

Age: ready for high school chemistry

Teacher: Beth Arpke (827-8940)

Class Fee: Families must obtain the textbook. The Thursday class will cost \$5.00 / student / semester for copies. Friendly Chemistry will cost \$2.00 / student / semester for copies. The cost for the spring labs is uncertain at this time.

### **Biology Lab**

Description: This will meet the lab requirement for a high school biology class.

Age: taking high school biology

Teacher: Beth Arpke (827-8940)

Class Fee: \$25.00 / year / student plus a dissecting kit

Curriculum: Students may be using any high school biology curriculum.

Length: all year

Time: This class will get together after registration and come up with an agreeable time to meet at the Filippi's home.

### **Drama**

Age: 8 years old up through 8<sup>th</sup> grade

Class Fee: copying charge of \$2.00 / student

Curriculum: none

Length: fall semester, but may also be offered in the spring

Time: 3<sup>rd</sup> hour on Thursdays

Class Size: open

### **Nutrition and Fitness**

Description: This is a high school elective which families may use for ½ credit. Students will learn about nutrition and healthy habits to care for their bodies. Relevant topics such as vegetarianism, exercise, and nutrient supplements will be discussed. Tests will be given. There will be outside homework, and grades will be given.

Age: 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

Class Fee: \$5.00 / student / year

Curriculum: none

Length: all year

Time: 2<sup>nd</sup> hour on Thursdays

Class Size: limited to first 15

### **Writing**

Description: This class will use Institute For Excellence In Writing materials developed by Andrew Pudewa, including use of a video by Mr. Pudewa. Outside writing will be part of this class, and grades will be given. Age: 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade

Teacher: Karla Dennis (825-7012)

Class Fee: \$17.00 / student (includes student workbook and copies)

Curriculum: see above

Length: all year

Time: 1<sup>st</sup> hour on Thursdays  
Class Size: open

### **U.S. Geography**

Description: This class will focus on regions of the United States and their distinctive characteristics. Children will become familiar with the states and also gain skills in reading and understanding maps.

Age: 6 and 7 year olds

Teacher: Gayle Pfannenstiel and Debbie Pica (827-7649 / 825-8980)

Class Fee: Gayle may use a book in which case parents will reimburse her, but the cost will be minimal, probably under \$5.00.

Curriculum: undecided at this writing

Length: fall semester

Time: 2<sup>nd</sup> hour on Thursdays

Class Size: open

Science A and Science B will both be taught by Nikole Bird (823-7390). She will be working from *The Backyard Scientist*, but it is not necessary for parents to buy this book. Nikole will be leading the students in performing fun, hands-on experiments to reinforce science concepts. The only difference between the two science classes is the age groupings.
