Nikole presented the treasures report showing \$5,265 as the current balance in the General Fund. \$2,683 in Gen Fund, \$1,767 in Choir & \$815 for Eagle Bots.

Volleyball balance of \$1,842 is where the season ended and all expenses have been accounted for.

Basketball balance is \$2,222 and the season is just getting started. Some concerns are present as basketball is starting with a lower balance than in previous years.
