Call to order: A special advisory meeting of the Smoky Valley Home Educators, Inc. was in held in Salina, KS at 300 S. 9th Street with President Mark Hoover presiding.

Topics of discussion: While discussing bylaw changes and reviewing past minutes, it was discovered that while SVHE representatives initiated the process to become a nonprofit in 2012 and were granted automatic, temporary approval, subsequent necessary filings to stay in good standing were not completed as funding to complete them was never agreed on by the membership and subsequently tabled. The advisory council discussed how to resolve these issues, and it would appear to the council that our membership has several options. Additionally, each option requires approval from our membership for funding and article changes to meet the qualifications for nonprofit status. It was decided that Mark Hoover would outline these options available to the group via a google doc to all advisory council members so we could present these options to our membership at a specially called business meeting in January.
