About This Supplement

This Volleyball Sport Supplement works alongside the SVHE Eagles Master Athlete and Family Handbook. It contains information specific to the Volleyball program — gear requirements, fees, schedules, contacts, and logistics.

The Master Handbook contains all conduct expectations, the code of conduct for athletes, parents and coaches, the consequences framework, and the Family Commitment Agreement. Every participant must read and sign the Master Handbook. This supplement provides the practical details you need before the first practice.

This supplement is maintained by the Volleyball Athletic Director and updated as needed. It does not modify the standards in the Master Athlete and Family Handbook. Questions about program policy belong to the Master Handbook and Sports Operations Manual.

Program Overview

SVHE Eagles Volleyball provides competitive team volleyball for girls at both the high school and junior high levels. The program emphasizes skill development, teamwork, and Christian character within a competitive environment.

Teams

Girls High School	Grades 9–12; players may not turn 19 before September 1st
Girls Junior High	Grades 6–8; players may not turn 15 before September 1st

Parental placement requests must be submitted to the Volleyball Athletic Director before the first game of the season. See the Sports Operations Manual for full eligibility details.

Registration and Fees

Registration	Complete SVHE registration at svhe.com before the first practice. Late fees apply after the published deadline.
Volleyball Handbook Form	In addition to the SVHE registration, players must complete and return the Volleyball Handbook acknowledgment form before the first practice. This form is available at svhe.com/volleyball .
Player Fee	Current fees are published in the registration forms at svhe.com and updated annually by the Athletic Board before each registration period opens.
SVHE Membership	Current membership and participation fees are published in the registration forms at svhe.com .

Gear Requirements

Players are responsible for providing their own gear. The following is required or recommended before the first practice:

- Athletic shoes appropriate for indoor court use
- Athletic shorts and shirt for practice
- Knee pads — strongly recommended for all players; coaches will advise on appropriate selection

Additional gear requirements will be communicated by the head coach at the start of the season.

Season Schedule

Season Dates	Announced at registration; typically runs in the fall
Practice Frequency	Generally two to three times per week; exact schedule set by head coach
Practice Location	Announced by head coach at the start of the season
Game Schedule	Published on the SVHE calendar at svhe.com
